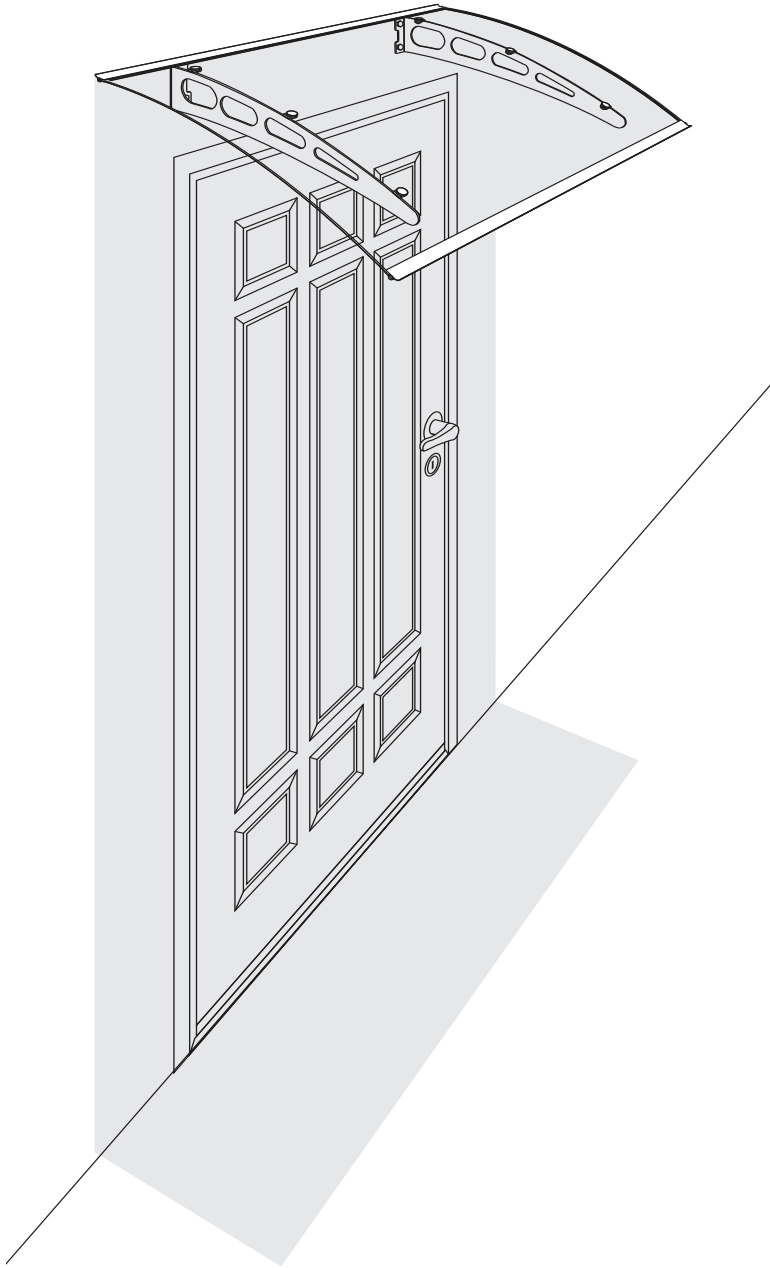

- C: Safety goggles

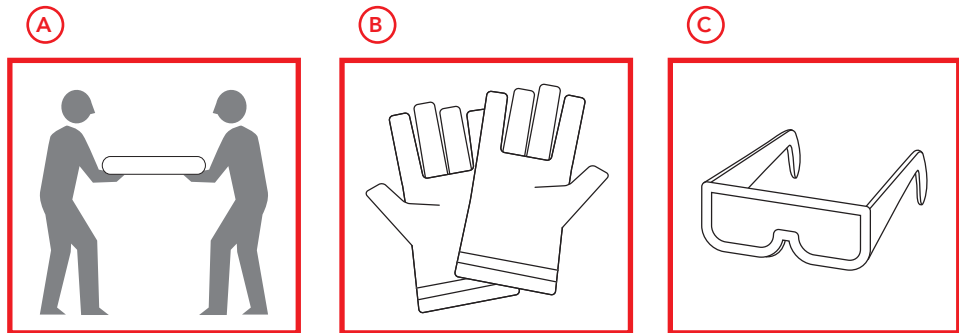

- F: You are tired or under the influence of drugs, medication or alcohol

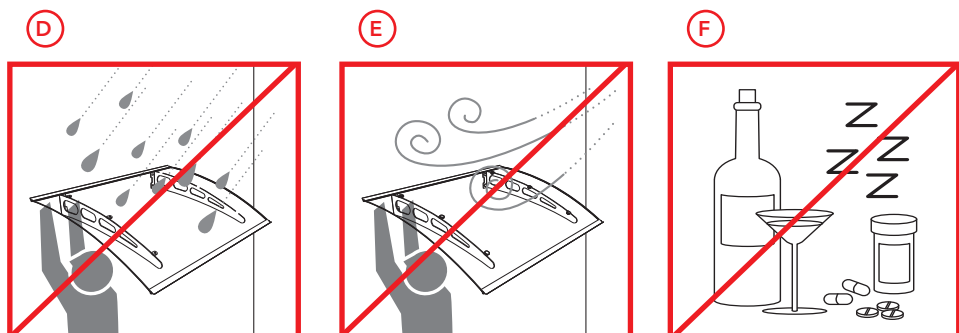

- Consult with your local authorities if any permits are required prior to the installation of this product. This product is intended for residential use only. Do not use this product other than for its intended purpose.

ASSEMBLY

- Please keep children away from the assembly area and from handling assembly components.
- Ensure that all screws are properly tightened when assembling the awning.
- Use caution with sharp metal edges by wearing protective gloves and safety goggles.
- Follow all 3rd party manufacturer's safety instructions when using mechanical power tools and ladders during assembly and installation.

INSTALLATION

- Pay close attention throughout the installation process to ensure that the Advaning awning is installed properly and according to the safety guidelines outlined herein.
- Do not attempt installation while under the influence of alcohol or drug substances.
- Do not proceed with an installation if you feel that you cannot properly and safely complete it; please seek professional help.
- Two or more people are recommended for installation. Installation will require lifting the assembled awning. Ascertain that assistance is available to lift and secure in position.
- Make certain that the installation substrate is adequate (the PA Series awning **MUST** be mounted to the main structural supports) studs, header board, or solid masonry 3-inch in thickness or greater.
- Do not drill into walls where electric wiring, gas pipes, or water pipes may exist.

USAGE

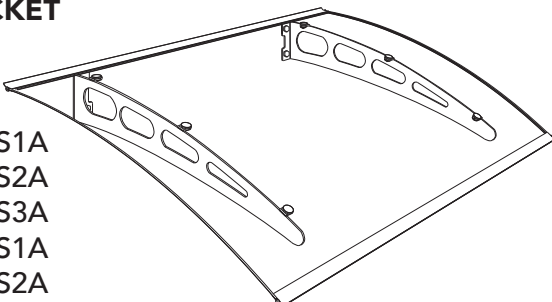
- Only use Advaning-recommended accessories and original replacement parts.
- Only perform installation, maintenance, and cleaning in dry and optimal weather conditions.
- Never put a heat source or an open flame under or near the awning.
- Do not place, hang, or stand objects or people on the awning itself. Doing so can damage the awning or cause severe personal injury and, in extreme cases, death.
- Do not carry out any maintenance other than what is shown in this manual. For any issues that are not covered in this manual, please seek support from Advaning Customer Service. Email: service@advaning.com
- The product should be used only as described within this owner's manual.

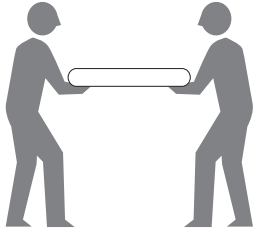

- ⑩ Ladder/s

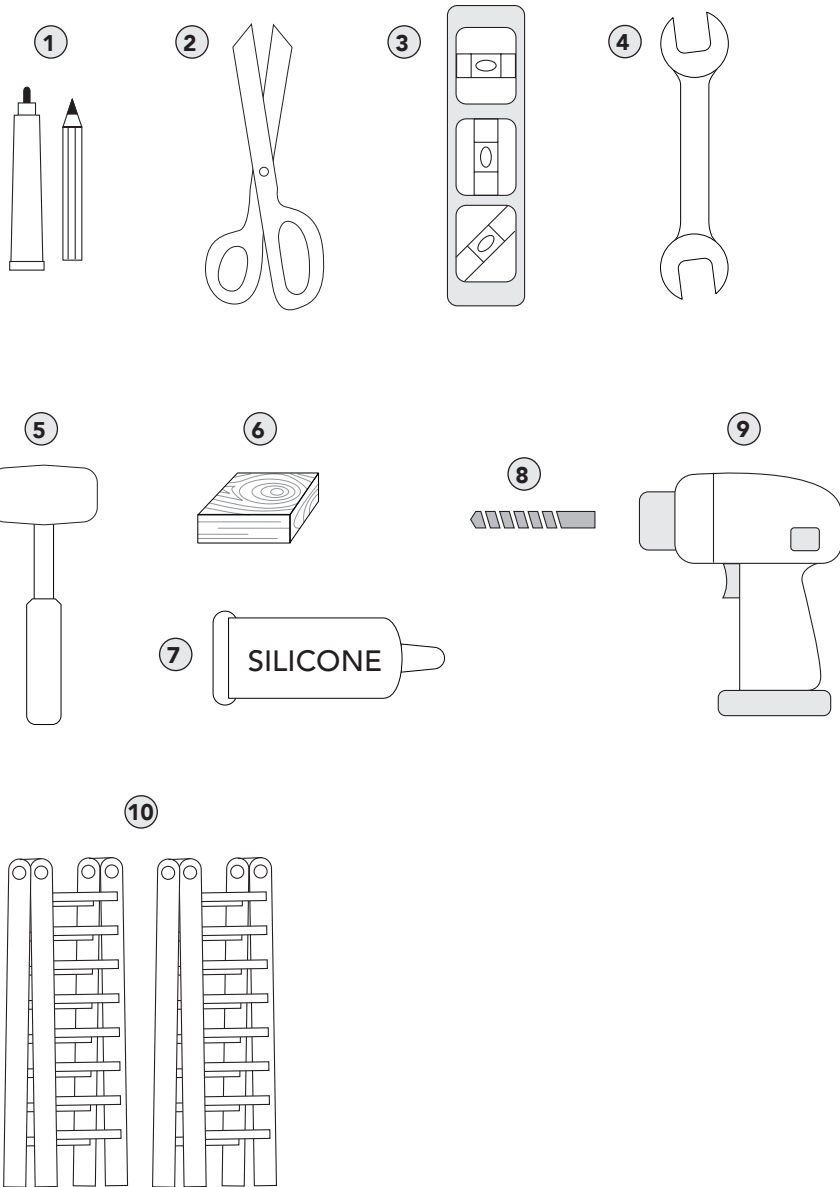
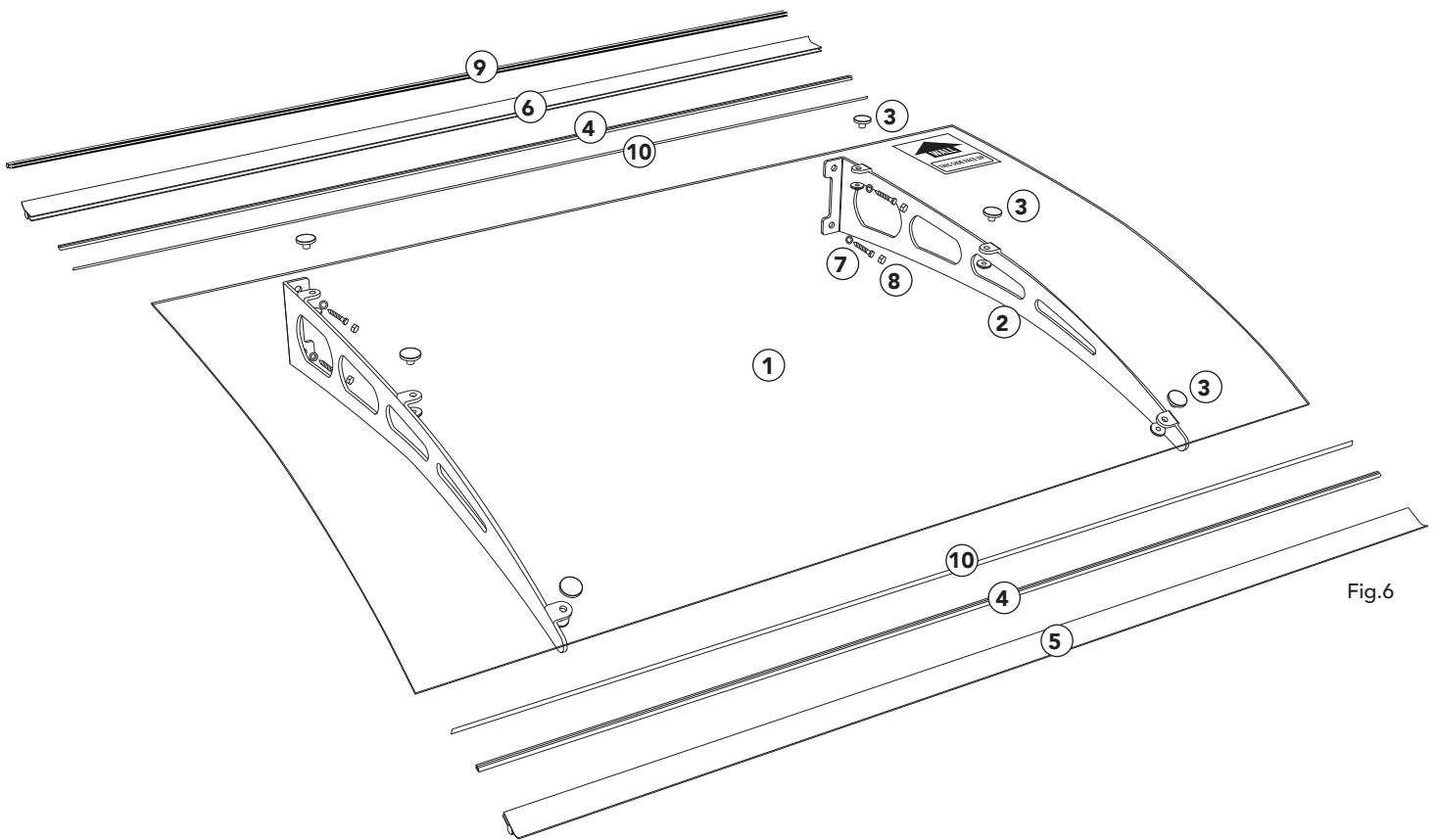

AWNING TERMINOLOGY AND LOCATION



- ① Awning Polycarbonat Sheet
- ② Awning Bracket
- ③ Bracket Bolt Set
- ④ Front/Back Rubber Strip
- ⑤ Awning Front Bar
- ⑥ Awning Back Bar
- ⑦ Mounting Hardware (Lag or Expansion)
- ⑧ Mounting Hardware Cap
- ⑨ Silicone Seal or Wall Rubber Strip Gasket (select models only)
- ⑩ Rubber Strip Adhesive

PRE-INSTALLATION GUIDE

PLANNING YOUR AWNING INSTALLATION

Locate your door/window structural header.

- Ⓐ Minimum 2 inches of clearance below roof/eave/overhang.
- Ⓑ 10 inches of clear vertical run length.
- Ⓒ Minimum Depth of 35 inches.



Run length should be free & clear of any obstructions along the entirety of planned awning length.

Advaning highly recommends consulting with a professional installer/contractor who can best assess your specific installation challenges to avoid possible injury, property damage and ensure full product functionality.

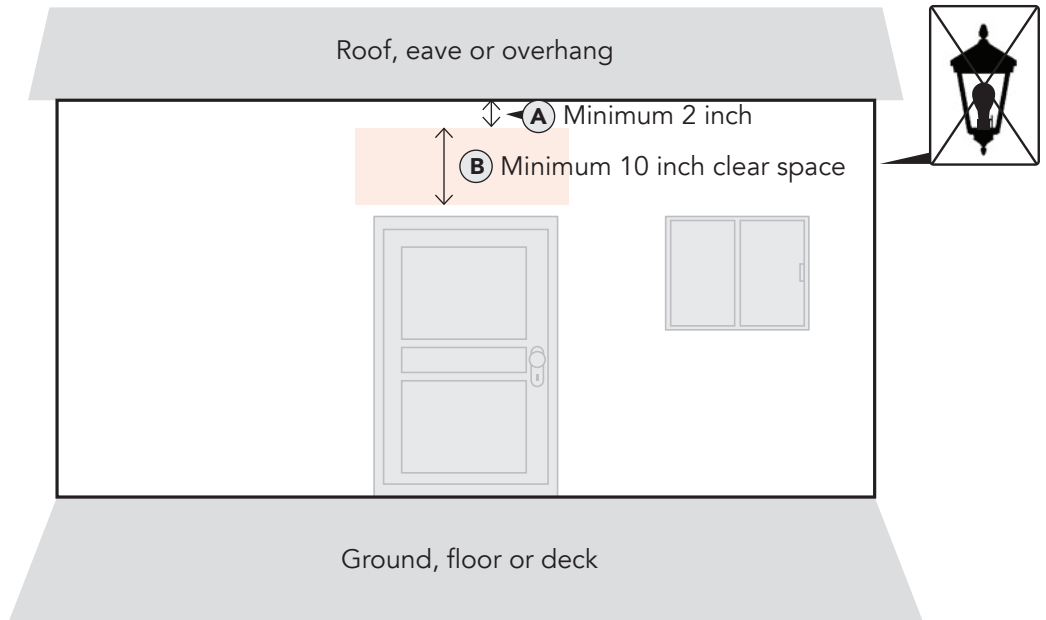

Side view

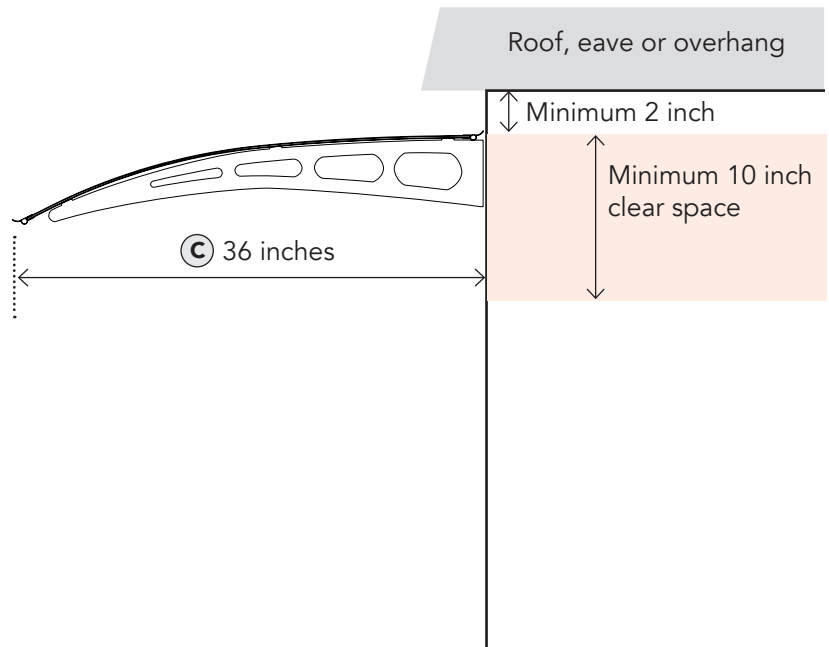

AWNING ASSEMBLY

PREPARING THE POLYCARBONATE SHEET

NOTE: Locate the indicating label on the polycarbonate protective film. This label will indicate the proper orientation.

① Carefully peel the protective film approximately 2 inches from both the top and bottom on front and back edges of the sheet.

② Peel the double sided Rubber Strip Adhesive Tape (Part I) apply the tape to the polycarbonate edges (top only) and carefully align and insert the Rubber Strip Gasket (Part C) and firmly press onto the adhesive tape to secure.

③ Ensure the Rubber Strip Gaskets are smoothly connected to the sheet and with scissors trim off the excess Rubber Strip Gasket.

④ Join the Awning Front/Back Bars to sheet by pressing onto the Rubber Strip Gasket edges. Ensure the Awning Front/Back Bar are correctly oriented as illustrated in fig. 11, labeled THIS SIDE UP.

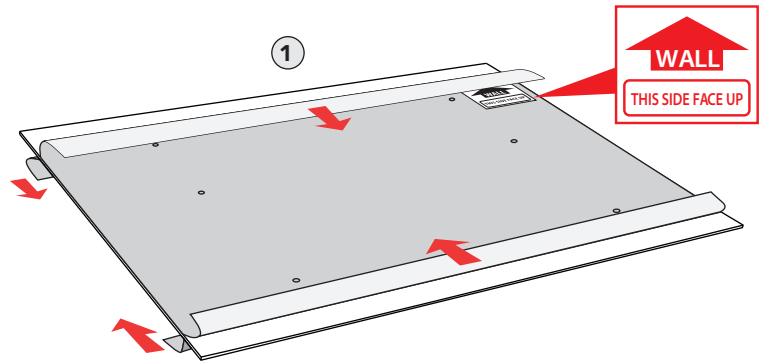

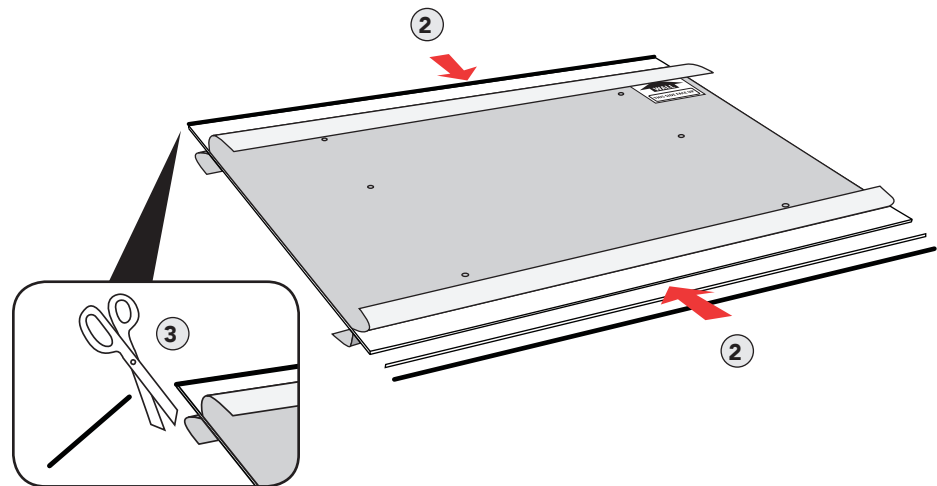

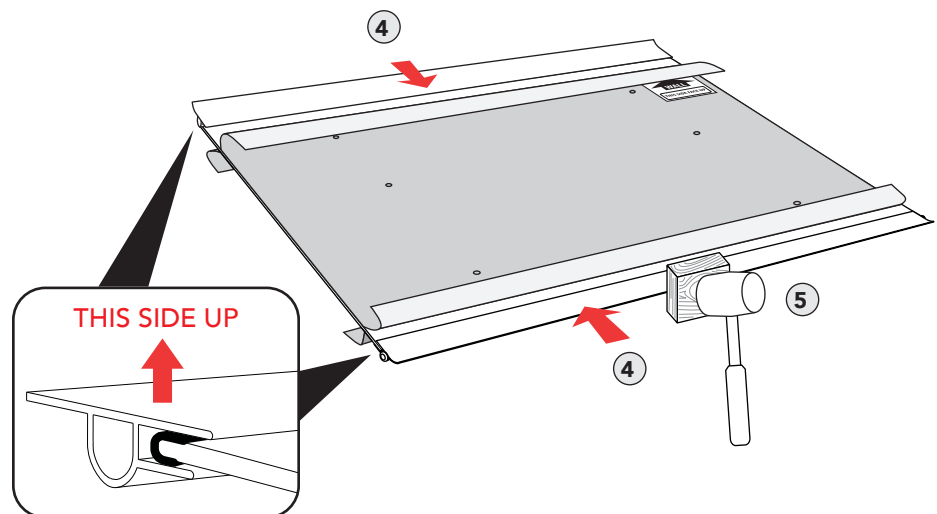

AWNING ASSEMBLY

- ⑤ Using a small wooden block and rubber mallet, tap along the entire length of the Awning
- ⑥ Carefully peel away the protective film from both the top and bottom.

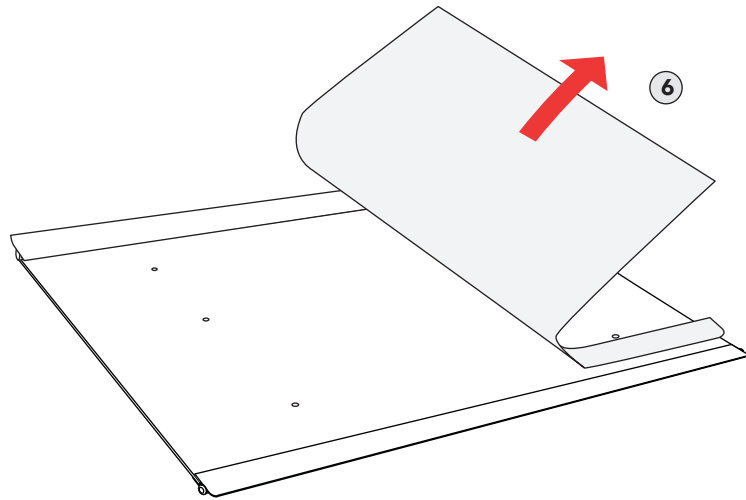

ATTACHING THE BRACKETS

- ⑦ From the bottom of the sheet, align the bracket to pre-drilled connection holes.
- ⑧ Secure the sheet to brackets with the Bracket Bolt Set (From Top: Bolt, Gasket, Sheet, Bracket, Gasket, Nut).

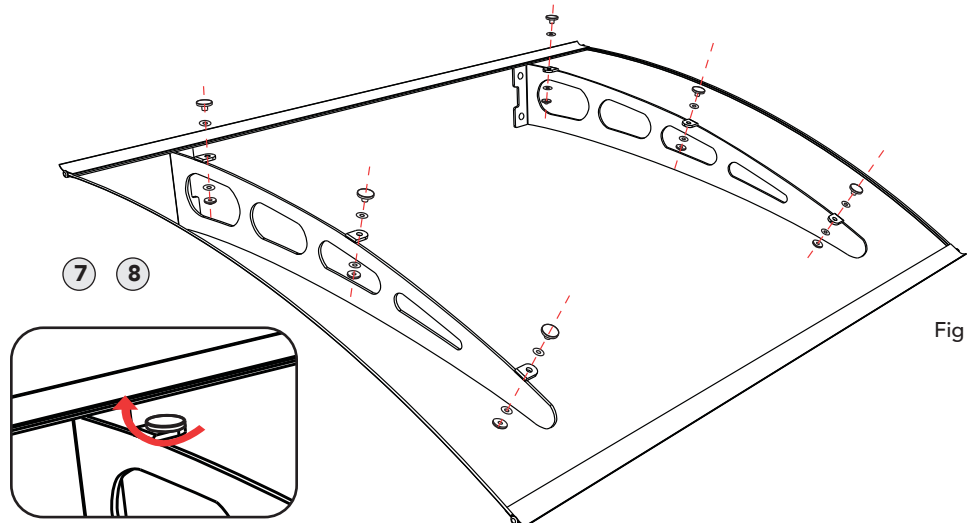

Sizes: 47x35 & 59x35 Only - Peel the double sided Rubber Strip Adhesive Tape (Part I) apply the tape to the Aluminum Back Bar (top only) and carefully align and insert the Wall Rubber Strip Gasket (Part H) and firmly press onto the adhesive tape to secure.

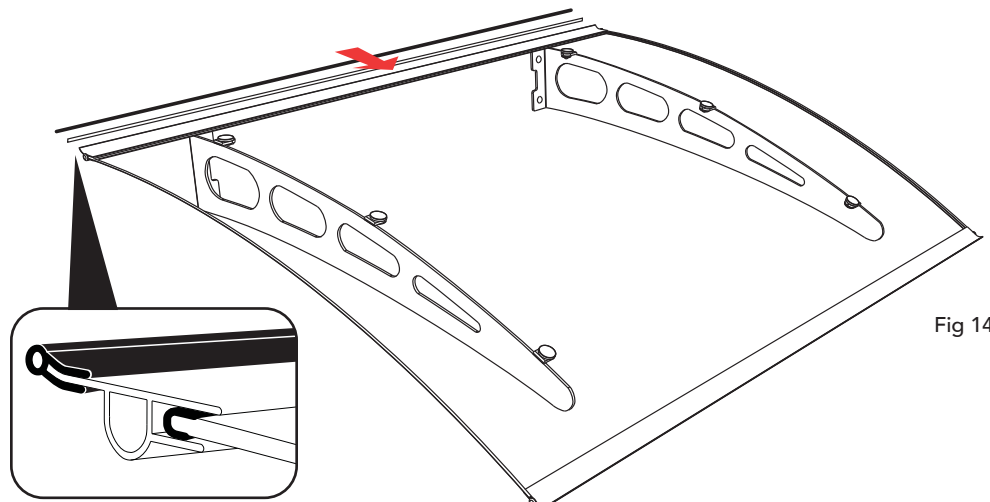

AWNING INSTALLATION

MARKING & PRE-DRILLING

- ① With a helper, hold the assembled awning in place over the desired installation area. Ensure to use a level for proper finish.
- ② With a marker/pencil mark the bracket mounting hole positions.
- ③ Using a power drill and drill bit, drill through your wall surface ensuring your pilot holes go through main structural supports.

CAUTION: DO NOT drill where electrical, gas, or water supply lines may exist.

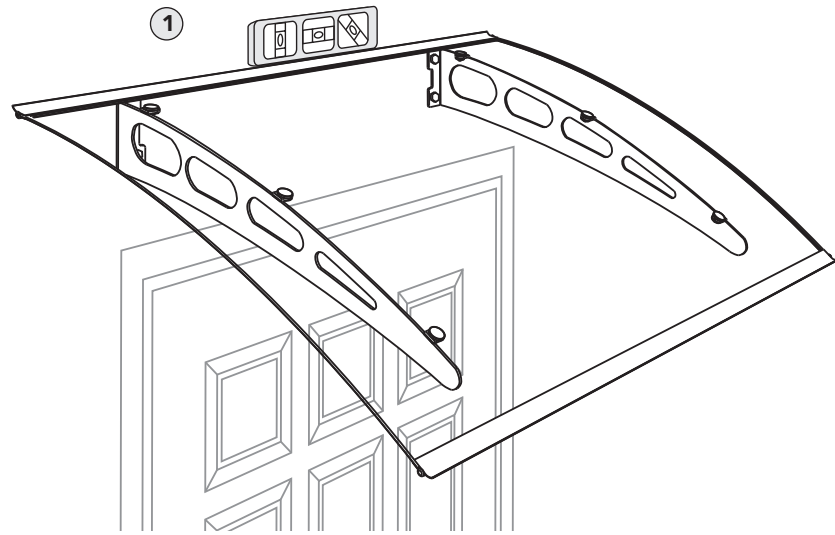

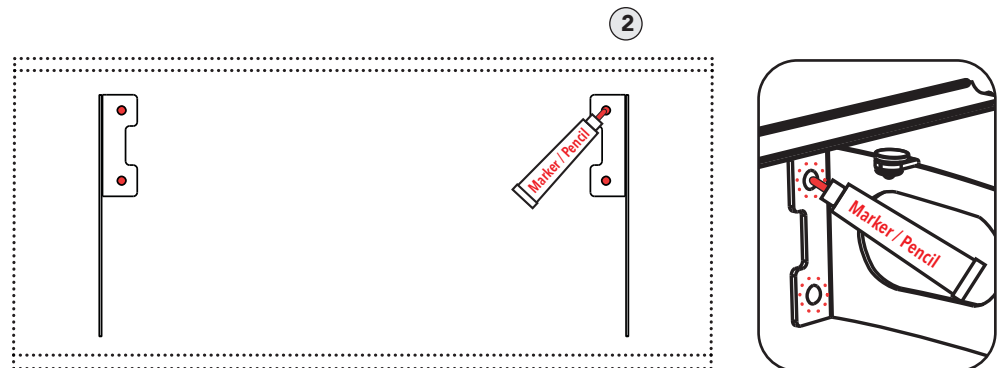

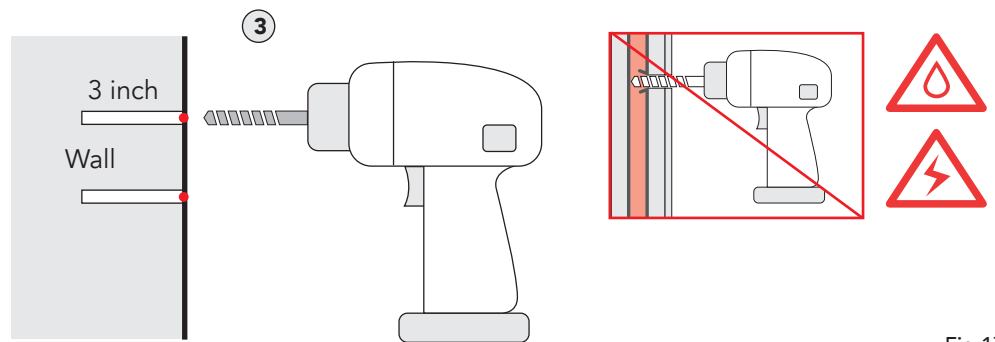

AWNING INSTALLATION

MOUNTING THE AWNING

④ Apply slow curing outdoor silicone directly into the pilot holes.

⑤ Align the awning brackets to pilot holes and insert the Lag Screw and Washer (illustrated).

NOTE: For solid masonry instructions, please visit or request detailed expansion bolt instructions via www.advaning.com

Ensure to check the product is level before securely tightening the mounting hardware.

⑥ Securely tighten the lag screw with a wrench/socket wrench.

⑦ Apply slow curing outdoor silicone around lag screw.

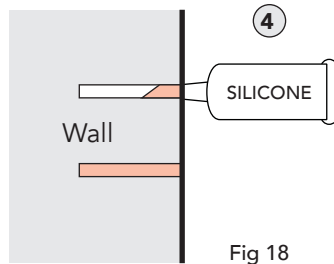

INSTALLATION

FINISHING & WEATHER PROOFING

- ⑧ Cover each lag screw with a Mounting Hardware Cap by gently tapping in place with a rubber mallet.
- ⑨ Apply a bead of slow curing outdoor silicone to the wall and Back Bar connection.

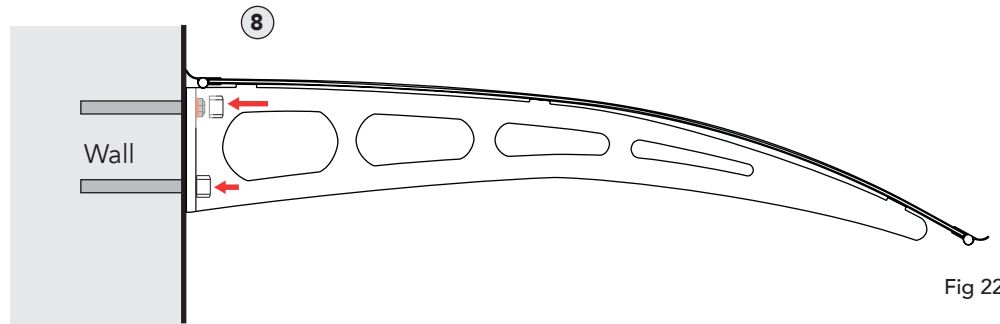

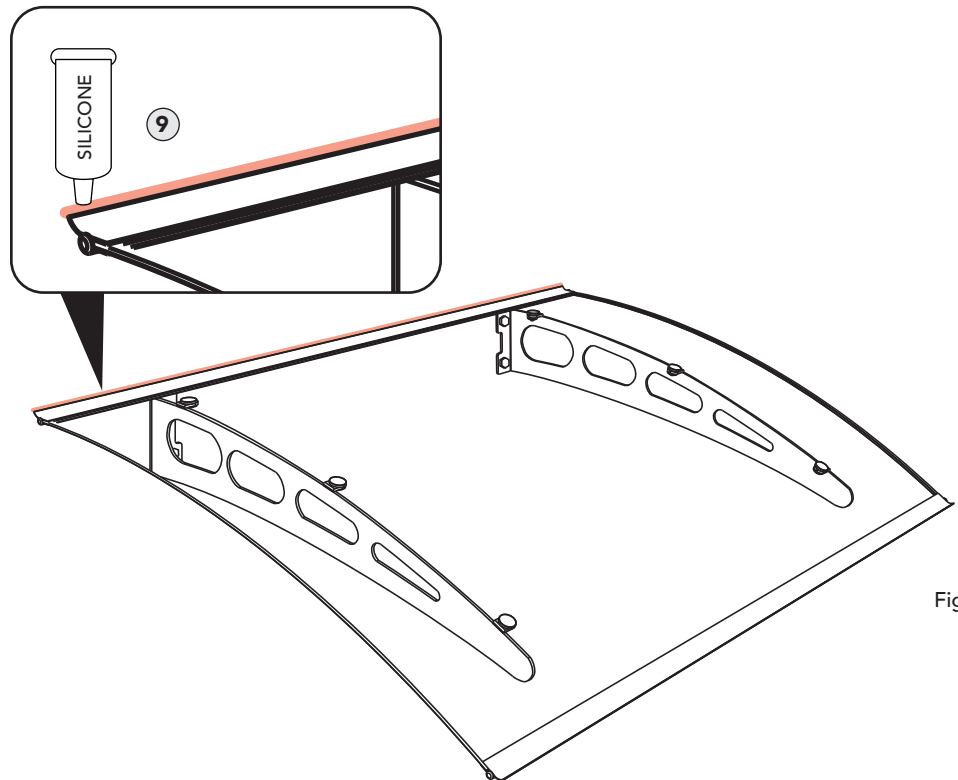

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

CLEANING

Cleaning the polycarbonate on your awning can be achieved with a simple solution of mild soap and water (1 part soap to 2 parts water) and a standard garden hose with a pressure nozzle to remove any accumulated dust, dirt, or debris. A specialty polycarbonate cleaner can be used, however, we recommend testing a small section before proceeding to entire polycarbonate. Never use acetone, abrasive cleaners, or other detergents to clean the awning.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Advaning recommends an annual inspection of the screw connections and seal condition. Tighten and replace parts or reapply silicone as needed. All parts can be easily obtained from Advaning should there ever be a need for replacement.

SNOW LOADS

Although the awning is made to handle significant loads, we recommend clearing accumulated and packed snow whenever possible. A long handled squeegee can be used to assist with removing excess snow. Please visit www.advaning.com for full independent weight capacity test results.

WARRANTY AND CUSTOMER SERVICE

ADVANING 1-YEAR LIMITED MANUFACTURER'S WARRANTY FOR PA SERIES AWNINGS

Advaning warrants all Advaning PA Series original products, sold and installed within the United States of America and Canada, to be free of defects in materials and workmanship. This warranty only applies to the original owner or purchaser of the product and is only effective on a basis for twelve (12) months or one (1) year from the date of purchase.

Any defects or issues presented to Advaning within the warranty period will be handled by Advaning Customer Service within a reasonable time.

The entire awning framework, including polycarbonate sheet, brackets and parts (page 3 of the Owner's Manual), is covered under the limited warranty.

Powder coated finishes and painted finishes are excluded and are NOT covered under this limited warranty.

During the warranty period, owners in Canada, Hawaii, Alaska, and Puerto Rico are covered for parts and replacements at no charge. However, the owner would assume all shipping and handling and applicable duties and taxes. Advaning's warranty does not cover any return shipping or prepaid return labels.

Should the original owner/purchaser submit a claim within the warranty period from the date of the purchase and after being deemed defective by Advaning, will the warranty claim be resolved by either of the following:

A. Defective components are replaced (shipping charges may apply).

and/or

B. Detailed correctional/resolving instructions will be provided.

EXCLUSIONS AND LIMITATIONS OF WARRANTY

ANY MODIFICATIONS OR ALTERATIONS TO THE PRODUCT WILL VOID THIS WARRANTY.

ADVANING, INCLUDING ITS SUBSIDIARIES AND AFFILIATES, SHALL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE IN ANY MANNER WHATSOEVER FOR INJURY, DEATH OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY AS A RESULT OF INTENTIONAL OR ACCIDENTAL MISUSED FOR PURPOSES FOR WHICH THE PRODUCT WAS NOT DESIGNED FOR.

The warranty will be in effect once the awning is fully paid for.

Advaning is not responsible for damage due to faulty modifications, installation, or re-installation. Advaning assumes no liability for damage to the structure to which the awning is attached, or to the property located underneath the awning. This limited warranty does not cover damage from ice, snow, hail, high winds, vandalism, neglect, improper use, or any natural disaster. This limited warranty does not cover degradation due to salt corrosion, oxidation, and chipping or peeling of the paint.

What is Not Covered by the Advaning Limited Warranty

This warranty is non-transferable and does not cover product purchases from the initial buyer to a third party. This warranty does not cover incidental damages, such as loss of time, loss of use, or installation costs of defective, repaired, or replaced products. This warranty does not cover products that have been damaged or rendered defective as a result of:

WARRANTY AND CUSTOMER SERVICE

- (a) Neglect, abuse or misuse.
- (b) Modification of the original product.
- (c) Improper use or installation using products not manufactured by Advaning.
- (d) Service provided by anybody other than Advaning.
- (e) Abnormal mechanical or environmental conditions.
- (f) Unusual physical or electrical stress -including failure or fluctuation of electrical power, lighting, static electricity, fire, tornadoes, or other natural disasters.

- Work performed by a third party or not authorized by an Advaning agent voids the warranty.

*Original Proof of Purchase: A valid sales/purchase receipt is required with authorized reseller/retailer name, the purchase date, and the model number of the item purchased.

SHIPPING DAMAGE/MISSING PARTS CLAIMS

On the occasion of a damage claim caused by the shipper/shipping company, the owner must contact their point of sale and the delivery carrier within 3-days of signing for the delivery in order to make a claim.

Likewise, there is a 7-day window from the time of delivery to report missing parts to Advaning.

Failure to report shipping damage and missing parts in a timely manner and in accordance with the shipper/ carrier guidelines may result in the owner incurring all costs.

THIS WARRANTY IS EXCLUSIVE AND IS IN LIEU OF ANY AND ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED.
